Around Tehran Shrine

Lots is happening, behind the scenes at Tehran Shrine, that you may be interested to know:

1. Our lawn sprinkler system is in need of tender love and affection. The timer wasn't running, several valve wires were disconnected, and some of the nozzles were either clogged or capped off. As a result, our lawn began looking pretty sickly and some of our trees had begun to feel the effects of our 100+ degree summer. We have restored the water and are in the process of having the lines flushed and new sprinkler heads installed. Once we're satisfied everything is again working as desired we'll address the issue of missing plants. If you'd like to donate a plant or two give Recorder Orron a call at (559) 251-1991.
2. Our roof also needs a little attention. We think some patching will get us further down the road but won't know for sure until a roofer gives us the real story. More to follow.
3. Did you notice, our Shrine Center heating and cooling thermostats have been upgraded. No longer can our units be left running for days on end. Plus, now we can manage the settings remotely via an app. Want the hall cooled an hour before your meeting? No problem - just let the office know what you need.
4. Speaking of the facility, this month we're going to task the Property Management Advisory Board (PMAB) to take on sprucing up our building a bit. Nothing major needs to be done, but we don't want to fall behind in our annual maintenance. PMAB members, you have been notified.
5. The Financial Management Advisory Board (FMAB) has been asked to research renting out more of our office space. Truth be told, we seldom use the offices in our Executive Suite. Rather than running a negative budget every year perhaps the additional rental income will help us achieve a balanced budget. Don't know whether the idea has merit, so we're waiting for the FMAB's report before considering our options.
6. We're doing great managing Tehran Shrine's annual Budget. John Denton presented for your approval the most austere spending plan we've had in many years. Even better, we're continuing to operate under that budget. With any luck we can delay pulling funds out of our investments for as long as possible (*while still having a great time.*)
7. There is an old Chinese curse which reads "May you live in interesting times." Imperial session begins on July 5th and there are many "interesting" items on the "Call" requiring our attention. Included among the proposed changes is an increase in per capita (*from \$30 per Noble to \$50.*) Additionally, an item which would eliminate the requirement for a Shriner to be a Mason. I'm expecting more fireworks than just those related to the 4th of July celebration...

HAPPY INDEPENDENCE DAY 4TH OF JULY!!

Did you know that the 4th has been a federal holiday since 1870, but it didn't become a paid holiday until either 1938 or 1941 (depends on your source). On July 2nd, 1776, the continental Congress voted in favor of independence and two days later delegates from the 13 colonies adopted the Declaration of Independence. Thomas Jefferson is credited with drafting it, but there were five men on the committee appointed by Congress, Jefferson, Adams, Sherman, Benjamin Franklin and Livingston. Adams never celebrated the 4th as he believed the 2nd was the proper date. Both Presidents Adams and Jefferson died on the 4th of July in 1826 (5 hours apart), the 50th anniversary of adoption. James Monroe (another President) died on the 4th, 1831. Calvin Coolidge was born on the 4th in 1872

George Washington issued double of rum to his soldiers to celebrate the day in 1778. Massachusetts made it a state holiday in 1781.

The first fireworks were used around 200 BC. The tradition of setting off fire works on the 4th started in Philadelphia in 1777. New York has the largest fireworks display (Macy's). They used 22 tons of fireworks in 2009. Bristol, Rhode Island holds the record for the oldest CONTINUOUS Independence Day celebrations in the US (held since 1785).
