The past few weeks have reaffirmed why I love being a Shriner and supporting Shriners Children's—we are truly an incredible organization.

Zuly and I just returned from the Assistant Rabban's seminar in Tampa, Florida, and we had an amazing time. The Shrine has evolved tremendously since I first joined in 1991 and has grown into a global healthcare provider for children. The days of 22 hospitals in North America and Mexico are behind us. Today, Shriners Children's operates 125 locations across 28 states and 30 countries. We have transitioned from a traditional hospital model to a more expansive approach, incorporating over 100 outpatient centers worldwide. This shift has allowed us to reach and care for more children in more countries than we ever imagined.

Excitingly, we are building a new hospital in Mexico that will significantly expand our capacity to serve children from Mexico and South America. In 2024 alone, Shriners Children's performed over 24,000 life-changing surgeries, 446,799 rehabilitation procedures, 59,431 prosthetic and orthotic deliveries, and welcomed 62,000 new patients—truly remarkable achievements!

Zuly and I look forward to seeing everyone at the upcoming events and sharing in the camaraderie that makes our Shrine so special.




